Braid is searching for an HSE Advisor to join our team in Ft. McMurray. The HSE Advisor reports directly to the Project Superintendent and indirectly to the Project Manager. This position is responsible for a variety of operational responsibilities related to the establishment and maintenance of a safe working environment in field projects.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Participate in regular meetings with the project management team and provide input, from a safety perspective towards achieving project schedules.
- Ensures employees have the minimum required training and PPE.
- Ensure all hazard assessments are completed and field level risk assessments are identified prior to beginning work activities.
- Participate and promote the Behavior Observation Program.
- Ensure pre-job safety meeting is held before construction work begins.
- Lead site-specific safety orientations.
- Conduct incident investigations.
- Ensure Alcohol & Drug testing is completed as per the corporate policy.
- Ensure the site safety management plan is followed for the project.
- Ensure corrective action is taken for safety related deviations.
- Ensure tailgate/toolbox meetings are held.
- Assist with the completion of safety audits.
- Ensure equipment and vehicle inspections are completed and meet safety requirements.
- Complete weekly statistical safety reporting for the project.
- Ensure H2S Bump Tests are complete.

- NCSO (National Construction Safety Officer) and/or CRSP (Canadian Registered Safety Professional) Designation.
- 3+ yrs of working experience in the Occupational Health and Safety Field (preferably in construction or oil & gas industry).
